



## OLHCC Curriculum Guide for Bachelor of Arts in Humanities (2009 - 2010)

The Humanities Degree requires the student to be proactive in pursuing a course of study that will meet his/her needs and interests. Within the context of a rigorous liberal arts curriculum, the student is free to create an area of major concentration from the Humanities enhanced by two other minor concentrations from the Humanities, thereby providing more effective preparation for the workplace or advanced graduate studies. Fifty-four hours of prescribed General Education courses are required, 30 hours in a major concentration and two 18 hour minors (above General Education requirements) for a total of 120 credits with six hours of study in a foreign language.
