Coast for Christ Baptist Ministries has been taking teams to Ghana for 14 years. Their vision is to minister to the fishing community along the Ghana coast. There are approximately 500,000 people along this 200 mile stretch of coast. For the most part, these people are uneducated, diseased, and poor. This ministry has built a school and provides education to 400 students. They also offer literacy training and vocational instruction in sewing, mechanics, carpentry, and masonry. They have
