Business Articulation Agreement

New Orleans, La. –Wednesday, Mar. 24, 2010 – Our Lady of Holy Cross College (OLHCC) and Delgado Community College signed an articulation agreement today designed to provide a seamless transition for Delgado students who desire to obtain a bachelor's degree in business from OLHCC.

The agreement ensures two-year business administration graduates from Delgado that their courses will automatically transfer into a baccalaureate business degree program at OLHCC. The agreement will begin to have an impact immediately, beginning with the fall 2010 semester.

On the OLHCC campus, Delgado Chancellor Ron White, Ph.D., and the Rev. Anthony J. De Conciliis, C.S.C., Ph.D., president of OLHCC, signed the agreement officially establishing a "2 + 2 program" that allows students who complete the courses prescribed in Delgado's Business Administration Associate of Science degree to transfer and obtain a Bachelor of Science degree from the Department of Business Administration at OLHCC.

"This formal agreement between Our Lady of Holy Cross College and Delgado Community College for their business degree program represents a unique public-private partnership, which will enable Delgado students to advance their educations to a higher level and focus more fully in the important areas of management, marketing and accounting," said DeConciliis.

"Sharing our educational resources and giving back to the community are basic, mission tenets of Our Lady of Holy Cross College," DeConciliis said. "We are pleased to be able to share our offerings with Delgado and to strengthen New Orleans' future business leadership."

"This is an important manifestation of the growing cooperation among Louisiana's higher education institutions," said Wright. "This agreement will enhance students' ability to make steady progress toward a bachelor's degree. It will also enable students to gain the education and relevant experience they need in a

timely and financially efficient manner to succeed in a competitive work environment.

“Not only does this partnership provide an outstanding educational opportunity for our mutual business students, it serves as a model program in support of the Greater New Orleans business community by educating the highly qualified business graduates needed to work within the region.”

Delgado students with an Associate of Science degree in Business Administration will be admitted as juniors in the Department of Business Administration at OLHCC provided they meet OLHCC admission requirements.

The total number of credit hours required to complete a bachelor’s degree from OLHCC is 127 semester hours, and students can transfer approximately half of that number, or 63 semester hours for degree credit, from Delgado. Under the “2+2 program” Delgado students will earn a bachelor’s degree from OLHCC after successfully completing at least 64 additional semester hours in the prescribed major at OLHCC and meeting all OLHCC degree requirements.

Puncky credits the exceptional spirit of cooperation between the two higher education institutions for the development and strong support of the program. “This agreement is the culmination of hard work by the staffs of both institutions,” he said. “With this collaborative venture, OLHCC and Delgado have laid the groundwork to better fulfill the needs of our students, providing them broader access to higher education that will ultimately enhance the quality of life in our communities. It’s a win for students and a win for higher education.”
