G.I. Bill

Did you know?

The Post-911 G.I. Bill for military veterans:

- available for up to 15 years after discharge or until the equivalent of one 4-year college education is paid for;
- available for the veteran and/or the veteran's spouse and dependents, and for the child of any military member who dies on active duty;
- in Louisiana, currently pays up to \$410 per credit hour or up to \$2542 per semester in tuition, plus a book allowance and living allowance;
- payments now made directly to the college by direct deposit

Military Spouse Career Accounts for the wives and husbands of active duty military personnel

- each spouse of an active military person now has a one-time \$6000 benefit to spend on education or job training.....currently in effect for USAF and will ultimately be implemented by all military services
