IMMUNIZATION POLICY

THE LOUISIANA LEGISLATURE HAS PASSED ACTS 1047, 251 AND 711, REQUIRING THAT STUDENTS BE IMMUNIZED AGAINST PREVENTABLE AND/OR COMMUNICABLE DISEASES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO: MEASLES, MUMPS, RUBELLA, AND TETANUS-DIPHThERIA, AND MENINGITIS.

THEREFORE, OLHCC REQUIRES ALL STUDENTS TO PROVIDE PROOF OF IMMUNIZATION AGAINST THE LISTED DISEASES. IF YOU WERE BORN AFTER JANUARY 1, 1957, WE NEED PROOF OF TWO LIVE MEASLES VACCINES. IF YOU WERE BORN PRE-1957, YOU MUST SUBMIT PROOF OF A TETANUS-DIPHThERIA THAT HAS BEEN ADMINISTERED WITHIN THE PAST 10 YEARS. YOU MUST HAVE YOUR PHYSICIAN OR HEALTH CARE PROVIDER COMPLETE AND RETURN THIS FORM.

CERTIFICATE OF IMMUNIZATION

Note: No registration for classes will be permitted without completion of this health form!

Why do I have to be immunized?

Louisiana State Public Health law requires students to demonstrate proof of immunity against measles, mumps, and rubella as a condition of attendance. Note: Documentation of two doses of live measles vaccine is required.

Does this law apply to me?

Yes! Students who were born prior to January 1, 1957 will be required to submit proof of a tetanus-diphtheria booster (dated within the past 10 years).

What steps should I take to comply?

1) Bring the OLHCC certificate of immunization (this form) to your physician or healthcare provider. The form can be completed based on information that you may have available, such as your high school or military records. You may also receive the required immunization at the time of your visit, if necessary.

2) Return the completed and signed certification of immunization to:

What happens if I don't comply?

- 1) You will not be able to receive Financial Aid.
- 2) You will not receive transcripts or grades.
- 3) You will not be allowed to pre-register for the upcoming semester until we have received your missing information.

Should I retain a copy of my proof of immunization?

Yes! Proof of immunization will be required to attend any college. It would be wise to have several copies available for future use. Therefore, we strongly suggest that you make several copies of your certificate of immunization before submitting the original to the Health Services Office or the Student Affairs and Admissions Office.
